Items 6 and 10 do not include Scott County data.

Item 2 - Minneapolis. And St.Paul data does not separate out ethnicity by race. St.Paul data includes arrests for juvenile arrests under 10.

Item 1- Pacific Islanders are combined with Asian due to their small population in Minnesota.
