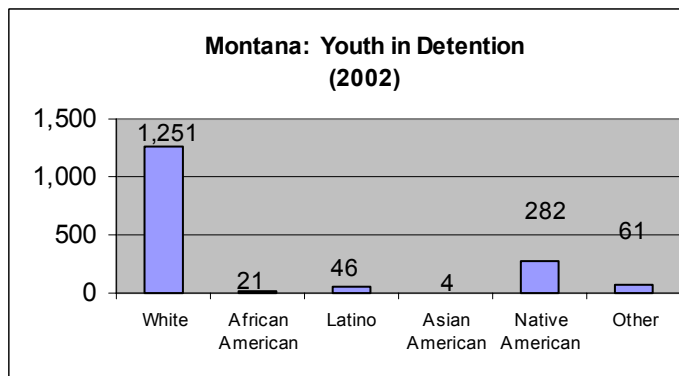
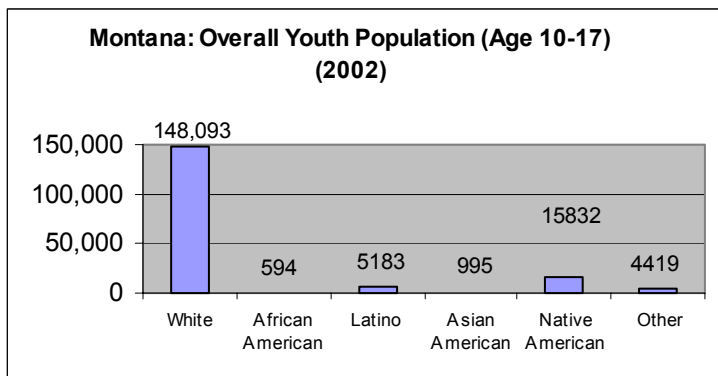

*CAPS is a database with integrated Child Protective Services and Juvenile Probation Information. The racial categories in CAPS are more comparable with the census racial categories than the categories available in the Juvenile Detention Reporting System (JDRS) database from which this detention information was extracted. Therefore the youth's CAPS ID numbers from the JDRS database were matched against the CAPS database racial information to produce better race information for the DMC report. In 2001 we added some front end edits to the JDRS database to screen the ID number entered into the CAPS ID field for conformation to the CAPS ID format. That screen improved data entry somewhat as evidenced by the drop in the number of non-matches, but there are still some ID's entered that don't have a corresponding number in the CAPS database.
